I shall be whiter than snow.


## CHORUS

# Scripture and History




## Psalm 27:1-14

**I** The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom should I fear? The LORD is my life's refuge; of whom should I be afraid?

When evildoers come at me to devour my flesh, these my enemies and foes themselves stumble and fall.

Though an army encamp against me, my heart does not fear; though war be waged against me, even then do I trust.

**II** One thing I ask of the LORD; this I seek: To dwell in the LORD's house all the days of my life, to gaze on the LORD's beauty, to visit his temple. For God will hide me in his shelter in time of trouble, He will conceal me in the cover of his tent; and set me high upon a rock. Even now my head is held high above my enemies on every side!
